### **New Features Released for RefAware and RefWorks**

*RefAware Now Includes Links to Author Profiles and the Inclusion of Images.  
RefWorks Announces Release of Write-N-Cite III and Write-N-Cite 2.5 for Mac.*

Along with all of these newly available capabilities to enhance search results, RefAware users are also able to create custom source sets and expand on the number of strategy creations within their account. These new features aim to bring greater search power to RefAware users.

With all the excitement surrounding the new RefAware enhancements, it is important to note that the newest enhancements are also available to RefWorks users. We are pleased to announce that Write-N-Cite III for Windows has completed beta testing, and the final release version is now available. This optional plug-in allows for single document formatting (and unformatting), as well as the ability to write and format a paper completely off-line, allowing users to be more mobile and efficient. For Mac users, Write-N-Cite v2.5 for Mac is also now available. This latest version works with Microsoft Word 2008 and the Leopard operating system and provides the same features as the current Write-N-Cite for Mac.

The Web-based nature of these products allow enhancements to automatically be put into place without the need for users to update or re-load software or make any other changes to their RefWorks accounts.
