RefWorks Announces Plans to Release Off-Line Capabilities

Previously, in order to utilize the program, RefWorks users were required to have an internet connection. With the upcoming release of Write-N-Cite 3.0, RefWorks users will now be able to use the program to write papers and generate bibliographies when not connected to the internet.

“The ability to use RefWorks off-line has been a frequently requested feature for RefWorks since its inception,” said Colleen Stempien, President of RefWorks. “Providing our users with the ability to manage their research from any location is essential. RefWorks will begin beta testing Write-N-Cite 3.0 for Microsoft Windows, including the new Vista operating system, in early Fall 2007.
